❖ Activity Outside the Work plan 2015 of BWP

1. Workshop on “Mapping Watsan Context, Conflicts, Policies, Stakeholders and Interventions in Bangladesh” and “Groundwater Resources Development in Bangladesh: Contribution to Water Supply and Constraints to Sustainability”.

Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC) Bangladesh recently organized a workshops on “Mapping Watsan Context, Conflicts, Policies, Stakeholders and Interventions in Bangladesh” and “Groundwater Resources Development in Bangladesh: Contribution to Water Supply and Constraints to Sustainability” perceptively on 09 and 14 July 2015 at the conference room of Hotel Lake Castle, Dhaka.

Bangladesh Water Partnership (BWP) was invited to participate in the workshops. Ms. Mukta Akter, Executive Secretary and Mr. Tauhidul Anwar Khan, Secretary General, BWP actively participated in the workshops.

The objective of the workshop was to provide technical and context related inputs to develop SDC WASH Governance Programme for Bangladesh. A study paper titled “WSS Situation and Possible future direction for SDC WASH Governance Programme” was presented by Dr. Haroon Ur Rashid, consultant of the programme and Professor, North South University of Bangladesh on 9 July 2015.

Approximately 60 participants from Govt. University and different multi-disciplinary organizations were present in each workshop and actively took part in the discussion. The workshops were followed by the brainstorming sessions to collect constructive feedbacks on the findings of study papers. The sessions were divided into 5 groups and The deliverables from each group were presented by the selective group member. Ms. Mukta Akter represented her group in the sessions on 09 July 2015.
